## THE PROJECT



In 2012, UNICEF has identified bullying as one of the major factors leading to under achievement, non attendance and drop out of children and young people from school. SafeSchool project aims at raising awareness about the harm that bullying causes and the way students can be protected presenting solutions in order to foster a safe environment based on respect, solidarity and social inclusion.

SafeSchool will design and implement a new anti-bullying programme in the schools of four different European countries. Drawing on the experience of the project partners, it will provide further evidence of effective approaches to the reduction of bullying in schools.

The project will result in training materials applying child centred approach and a blended teachers training for the prevention and monitoring of bullying and the evaluation of the effectiveness of the measures adopted by the schools.

## OBJECTIVES

SafeSchool will:

1. Reduce number of incidents and impact of violence at school.
2. Improve strategies and responses to incidences of bullying and help avoid recurrence.
3. Train teachers in the empowerment of all school staff and parents as change agents in reducing bullying and in the education of children and young people.
4. Disseminate widely the results of the project.



## IMPLEMENTATION

The project is divided into four phases:

**Phase 1:** Research and analysis to combine the experience and existing successful practices of the participating partner countries. Initial focus group interviews and consultations with the schools to clarify the needs of teachers, children and young people.

**Phase 2:** Development of the training program for teachers: content, activities and on line platform.

**Phase 3:** Implementation and evaluation of the training programme by the teachers involved in the project.

**Phase 4:** Review of the programme materials by the participants.



## MAIN DELIVERABLES

- Research analysis report;
- Teachers on line training programme;
- Open Educational Resource platform for teachers;
- Tutorial Contribution of teachers from their experience in implementing bullying training in their school;
- Short Term Joint Staff Training Event for staff and blended mobilities for teachers/school staff/school learners on bullying reduction;
- Networking and wide ranging dissemination and publication of the results.
